

BORAX MINES UNDER SNOW

Scott Russell came in from the borax mines at Stauffer Wednesday evening. He reports that there is yet a large amount of snow in the mountains and he was only able to get out by leaving at midnight and riding his mule over the frozen snow before day break. The winter has been very severe and the loss to the stockmen has been great. Hundreds of head of stock have perished during the winter. There has been no work of any kind at the mines owing to the deep snows. Manager Calm of the Columbia Borax mines came to Stauffer from New York early in the winter hoping to install a big roaster but the machine and all its equipments are at Lancaster and Calm is snowbound. Scot says it will be some time before the mines are accessible.
